श्रीतक m. (-कः) 1. Cold weather or the cold season, winter. 2. A lazy man, one who is dilatory or dull. 3. One devoid of care or anxiety, a happy man. 4. A plant, (Marsilea dentata.) 5. A scorpion. E. कन् added to the preceding.

श्रीतकाल n. (-लः) Cold weather, winter. E. श्रीत, and काल time.

श्रीतकालीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Produced in winter. E. श्रीतकाल, and ख aff.

श्रीतकण्डू m. (-कण्डूः) A religious penance, drinking cold water three days, cold milk three days, cold Ghee three days, and fasting three. E. श्रीत cold, and कण्डू, penance.

श्रीतकुम्भ m. (-कुम्भः) A flower, (Nerium odorum.) f. (-कम्भा) An aquatic plant. E. श्रीत cold, कुम्भ a water-pot.

श्रीतचार n. (-चः) Refined Borax. E. श्रीत cold, चार nitre. "श्रीतदृश्ये ।"

श्रीतगन्ध n. (-गन्धः) White Sandal. E. श्रीत cold, and गन्ध smell.

श्रीतगु m. (-गुः) 1. The moon. 2. Camphor. E. श्रीत cold, and गु neut. form of गो a ray of light, here forming a masc. compound.

श्रीतचम्पक m. (-कः) 1. A lamp. 2. Pleasing, satisfying. 3. A mirror. E. श्रीत cold, cool, and चम्पक a flower.

श्रीतता f. (-ता) Cold, coldness. E. श्रीत, and तल् aff. ; also with ल, श्रीतल ।

श्रीतद्विधिति m. (-तिः) The moon.

श्रीतपर्णी f. (-पर्णी) A plant, (Cleome pentaphylla.) E. श्रीत cool, पर्ण a leaf.

श्रीतपद्म m. (-पद्मः) A plant, (Ardisea solanacea.) E. श्रीत cool, पद्म a shoot.

श्रीतपाकानौ f. (-नौ) A medicinal root, commonly Kākoli. E. श्रीत the cold, (in a cold climate,) पाक ripening, and इनि aff.

श्रीतपाकौ f. (-कौ) 1. A medicinal root, commonly Kākoli. 2. A plant, (Sida cordifolia.) E. श्रीत cold, (in cold weather, &c.) पाक a ripening, कौप् fem. aff.

श्रीतपुत्र m. (-पुत्रः) The Sirisha tree. n. (-पुत्रः) A fragrant grass, (Cyperus rotundus.) E. श्रीत cold, (in the cold weather, &c.) and पुत्र a flower.

श्रीतपुत्रक n. (-कः) Storax or Benzoin. E. श्रीत cold, (in the snowy mountains,) पुत्र a flower, कन् aff.

श्रीतप्रभ m. (-भः) Camphor. E. श्रीत cool, and प्रभ shining.

श्रीतभानु m. (-नुः) The moon. E. श्रीत cool, भानु the sun. [भीरु afraid.]

श्रीतभीरु f. (-रुः) Arabian jasmine, (Jasminum zambac.) E. श्रीत the cold,

श्रीतभोजिन् mfn. (-जि-जिनी-जि) Eating cold viands. E. श्रीत, भुञ् to eat, चिनि aff. [of light.]

श्रीतमयूख m. (-खः) 1. The moon. 2. Camphor. E. श्रीत cool, मयूख a ray

श्रीतमरीचि m. (-चिः) The moon. E. श्रीत cool, मरीचि a ray. [सूलक a root.]

श्रीतमूलक n. (-कः) The root of the Andropogon muricatum. E. श्रीत cool,

श्रीतरस्य m. (-स्यः) A lamp. E. श्रीत cool, and रस्य agreeable.

श्रीतरश्मि m. (-श्मिः) The moon. E. श्रीत, and रश्मि light.

श्रीतलम् mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Cold, chilly, frigid. n. (-लं) 1. Green vitriol. 2. Storax. 3. Sandal. 4. White Sandal. 5. A lotus. 6. A pearl. 7. Cold, coldness. 8. The root of the Andropogon muricatum. m. (-लः) 1. A plant, (Marsilea quadrifolia.) 2. A Jina or Jaina teacher, the 10th of the twenty-four Tirt'hakārs. 3. श्रीतलवात m. (-तः) A cool wind. E. श्रीतल, and वात wind.

श्रीतलवातक m. (-कः) A plant, (Marsilea quadrifolia.) E. श्रीतल cool, वात wind, कप् added.

श्रीतलषष्ठी f. (-ष्ठी) The sixth of the light-half of Ma'gha, when only cold food is eaten. E. श्रीतल, and षष्ठी sixth.

श्रीतशिव n. (-शिवः) 1. A sort of resin, (Storax benzoin.) 2. Rock salt. m. (-शिवः) 1. A kind of fennel, (Anethum sowa.) 2. The S'ami-tree, (Mimosa suma, Rox.) E. श्रीत cool, and शिव auspicious.

श्रीतशुक m. (-कः) Barley. E. श्रीत cold, and शुक an awn or beard.

श्रीतसह mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) Bearing or enduring cold. m. (-हः) A Pilu, or tree so named, growing in the Hima'laya mountains. E. श्रीत cold, and सह enduring.

श्रीतहर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Removing cold. E. श्रीत, and हर what takes.

श्रीतांशु m. (-शुः) 1. Camphor. 2. The moon. E. श्रात cold, श्शु a ray.

श्रीताकुल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Benumbed, frozen. E. श्रीत, आकुल perplexed.

श्रीताद m. (-दः) Scorbutic affection of the gums. E. श्रीत, द what eats.

श्रीताद्रि m. (-द्रिः) The snowy mountain. E. श्रीत cold, द्रि a mountain.

श्रीतार्च mfn. (-र्चः-र्चा-र्चं) Cold, chilled, shivering, suffering or shrinking from cold. E. श्रीत cold, and आर्च' pained.

श्रीतलु mfn. (-लुः-लुः-लुः) Cold, shivering, shrinking from cold. E. श्रीत cold, आलुच् aff., here implying aversion or impatience.

श्रीताश्मन् m. (-श्मन्) The moon-gem, crystal. E. श्रीत cold, अश्मन् a stone.

श्रीतीभाव m. (-वः) 1. Final emancipation. 2. Coolness, composure. 3. Cold, coldness. E. श्रीत cold, भाव nature, वच् augment.

श्रीतीक्ष्ण n. (-क्ष्णः) Water. E. श्रीत cold, उक्ष्ण best.

श्रीत्य mfn. (-त्यः-त्या-त्यं) 1. Ploughed, tilled: more usually श्रैत्य. 2. To be cooled or chilled. E. श्रीत cold, or श्रैता a furrow, यत् aff.

श्रीत्कार m. (-रः) Uttering a sound expressive of pleasurable sensations. E. श्रीत् imitative sound, and कार making: also with कृत made, uttered, श्रीत्कृत n. (-कृतः) । [Una'di aff. धृक् ।

श्रीधु mn. (-धुः-धुः) Rum, distilled from molasses. E. श्रौ to sleep, or rest,

श्रीधुगन्ध m. (-गन्धः) A plant, (Mimusops elengi.) E. श्रीधु Rum, गन्ध smell.

श्रीधुप mf. (-पः-पी) A drinker of spirits, a dram-drinker. E. श्रौधु spirits, and पा to drink, aff. टक् ।

श्रीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Thick, congealed, (as oil or butter.) m. (-नः) 1. A fool, a blockhead. 2. A large snake. E. श्रौ to go, aff. ऋ ।

श्रीफालिका f. (-का) A flower, (Nyctanthes tristis :) see श्रेफालिका ।

श्रीभ (ञ्) श्रौभ r. 10th cl. (श्रीभते) 1. To flatter. 2. To boast. 3. To say.

श्रीभव m. (-वः) Thin rain.

श्रीभ्य m. (-भ्यः) 1. S'IVA. 2. A bull. E. श्रौभ to praise, यत् aff.

श्रीयमान mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Going away, dissipating, dispersing, departing. E. श्रद् to go, शानच् aff. ; श्रौय substituted for the radical letters.

श्रीर m. (-रः) A large snake, (Boa constrictor.) 2. A plough. E. श्रौ to sleep, रक् Una'di aff.

श्रीर्ष mfn. (-र्षः-र्षां-र्षं) 1. Thin, small, slender. 2. Wasted, withered, decayed. E. श्रु to injure, aff. ऋ, form irr. [ल, श्रीर्षल ।

श्रीर्षता f. (-ता) Emaciation, withering. E. श्रीर्ष, and तल् aff. ; also with

श्रीर्षनाला f. (-ला) A plant, (Hemionites cordifolia.) E. श्रीर्ष shrivelled or slender, नाल stem.

श्रीर्षपत्र m. (-पत्रः) A tree, (Pterospermum acerifolium.) E. श्रीर्ष withered, पत्र a leaf. [पाद a foot.]

श्रीर्षपाद m. (-दः) An epithet of the planet Saturn. E. श्रीर्ष shrivelled,

श्रीर्षपुष्पिका f. (-का) A kind of fennel, (Anethum sowa.) E. श्रीर्ष shrunk, पुष्प a flower, कन् aff., fem. form.

श्रीर्षवृन्त n. (-वृन्तः) A water-melon. E. श्रीर्ष slender, and वृन्त foot-stalk.

श्रीर्षाङ्गि m. (-ङ्गिः) YAMA, judge of the dead. E. श्रीर्ष shrivelled, अङ्गि a foot: being shrunk up in consequence of a curse of his mother's.
