

शुद्रावेदिन् m. (-दी) A man of the three first classes, who has a S'u'dra wife. E. शुद्रा, and आवेदिन् who marries.

शुन mfn. (-नः-ना-ने) 1. Swelled, increased, grown. 2. Morbidly swollen. f. (-ना) 1. A shambles, a slaughter-house. 2. The soft palate. 3. A piece of house-hold furniture which destroys animal life. viz :—
 “पञ्च शुना गृहस्थस्य चुह्वीपिष्युपस्करः ।
 कण्ठनीचोदकुम्भश्च बध्यते घातु वाहयन् ॥”
 E. श्चि to increase, aff. क्त, form irr.

शुनावत् m. (-वान्) A butcher, one who keeps a place where animals are killed for sale. E. शुना a shambles, and मतुप् aff.

शुन्न् mfn. (-न्-न्-न्) 1. Empty, void. 2. Lonely, desert. 3. Vacant. 4. Dvoid of. 5. Indifferent. 6. Guileless. 7. Absent-minded. 8. Nonsensical. 9. Naked, bare. n. (-न्) 1. Heaven, sky, æther. 2. A dot, a spot. 3. A cipher. 4. A vacuum. 5. Non-entity. f. (-न्वा) 1. A hollow reed. 2. The prickly-pear. 3. A barren woman. E. शुन a dog, यत् aff. of fitness, and the vowel substituted for the semi-vowel, and made optionally long.

शुन्यगेह n. (-ह) An empty or deserted house. E. शुन्न्, and गेह a house.

शुन्ल n. (-ल) 1. Vacuity, emptiness. 2. Unreality, the false or illusory nature of all existence. E. ल added to शुन्न्; with तल्, शुन्लता ।

शुन्मध्य m. (-ध्यः) A hollow reed. E. शुन्न् empty, and मध्य the middle.

शुन्मुख Adj. Pale-faced, having a dejected countenance.

शुन्वादिन् m. (-दी) 1. A Baudd'ha. 2. An atheist. E. शुन्न् vacuum, and वादिन् declaring; denying the existence of any thing.

शुन्स्थान n. (-न) An empty place. E. शुन्न्, and स्थान place.

शुन्हस्त mfn. (-स्तः-स्ता-स्त) Empty-handed. E. शुन्न्, हस्त the hand. [शानच् aff.

शुन्मान mfn. (-नः-ना-न) Swelling, enlarging, expanding. E. श्चि to swell,

शूर r. 10th cl. (शूरयति-ते) 1. To be valiant or powerful, to act the hero. 2. To make great effort or exertion. (ई) शूरी r. 4th cl. (शूर्यते) 1. To hurt or kill. 2. To be stupid.

शूर m. (-रः) 1. A hero. 2. The sun. 3. A lion. 4. A boar. 5. The grandfather of KRISHN'A. 6. The S'al tree, (Shorea robusta.) f. (-रा) Brave, mighty. E. श्च to bear, Sautra root, Una'di aff. क्तन्, and the vowel made long; or शूर to be brave, aff. अच् ।

शूरकौट m. (-टः) A contemptible warrior.

शूरण m. (-णः) 1. An esculent root, (Arum campanulatum, Rox.) “शूल.” 2. A plant, (Bignonia Indica.) E. शूरी to hurt, (some diseases,) aff. युच्; or शूर्-ल्यु । [भुज् to eat, aff. क ।

शूरबोहुज m. (-जः) A kind of bird. E. शूरण the Arum, and उद् before

शूरता f. (-ता) Heroism, prowess. E. तल् added to शूर; also with ल, शूरल ।

शूरदेव m. (-वः) The second Jaina of the future era.

शूरमान n. (-न) Vaunting, pride of prowess. E. शूर, and मान pride.

शूरमानिन् m. (-नी) A boaster, one who thinks himself a hero. E. शूर. मन् to think, लिति aff. [to think, खम् aff.

शूरमन्व m. (-न्वः) A boaster, one who thinks himself a hero. E. शूर, मन्

शूरसेन m. (-नः) 1. The country about Mathurá. 2. The name of a prince. E. शूर a hero, सेना an army.

शूर्प r. 10th cl. (शूर्पयति-ते) To mete or measure.

शूर्प mn. (-र्पः-र्प) 1. A winnowing basket. 2. A measure of two Dro'nás. f. (-र्पी) 1. A small kind of winnowing basket, a toy for children. 2. The sister of RA'VAN'A : see शूर्पनखा. E. शूर्प to injure, Una'di aff. प, and ऊ substituted for the vowel; or शूर्प-चञ् ।

शूर्पक m. (-कः) A demon, the enemy of KA'MADÉVA. E. शूर्प to measure, aff. खल् ।

शूर्पकर्ण m. (-र्णः) An elephant. E. शूर्प a winnowing basket, कर्ण the ear.

शूर्पकाराति m. (-तिः) KA'MA or CUPID. E. शूर्पक a demon, and काराति an enemy; also शूर्पकारि, &c.

शूर्पशखा f. (-खा) The sister of the Daitya RA'VAN'A. E. शूर्प a winnowing basket, and नख a finger nail, (having them as large,) fem. aff. टाप् or डीप्, whence also शूर्पशखी ।

शूर्पनिषाव m. (-वः) A measure (a basket) of winnowed corn. E. शूर्प, निषाव winnowing.

शूर्पशर्बी f. (-र्बी) A sort of bean, (Phaseolus trilobus.)

शूर्पवात m. (-तः) The air as agitated by the shaking of the winnowing basket. E. शूर्प a basket, वात wind. [as large.

शूर्पश्रुति f. (-तिः) An elephant. E. शूर्प winnowing basket, श्रुति an ear; शूर्प m. (-र्षः) An iron image, &c., also शूर्पः see the next.

शूर्पि mf. (-र्षिः-र्षी) 1. An iron image. 2. An anvil. E. श्रु for श्रीभा beauty, and ऊर्षि a wave or line, डीष् optionally added; deriv. irr.; also with इ rejected, and कन् added, fem. form शूर्पिका; again, as differently read, शूर्पि, श्रुर्षि, &c.

शूल r. 1st cl. (शूलति) 1. To disorder, to distemper or disease. 2. To make a loud noise. 3. To impale, to transfix.

शूल mn. (-लः-ल) 1. Sharp pain in general, or especially in the belly, as colic, &c., or in the joints, from rheumatism or gout. 2. A weapon, a pike, a dart. 3. An iron pin or spit. 4. A banner, an ensign. 5. An astrological Yo'ga, that of the 9th lunar mansion. 6. Death, dying. 7. A stake for impaling criminals. f. (-ला) 1. A whore. 2. An instrument used for putting criminals to death, a stake for impaling them. E. शूल to disease, &c., aff. अच् or क ।

शूलक m. (-कः) A restive horse. E. शूल to distress, वृन् aff.

शूलघातन n. (-न) Iron rust or filings. E. शूल pain, घातन what removes.

शूलघ्न mfn. (-घ्नः-घ्नी-घ्ना) Removing or allaying sharp pain, sedative, anodyne. E. शूल, and घ्न what destroys.

शूलधन्वन् m. (-न्वा) S'IVA. E. शूल a pike or the three-pronged one, the trident of this deity, धन्वन् a bow, put for a weapon. [holds.

शूलधर m. (-रः) S'IVA. f. (-रा) DURGA'. E. शूल a pike or trident, धर who

शूलधृष् f. (-धृक्) DURGA'. E. शूल a trident, and धृष् to be bold, aff. क्तिप्.

शूलनाशन n. (-न) White Sachal-salt. E. शूल colic, and नाशन removing.

शूलशतृ m. (-तृः) The castor-oil plant, (Ricinus communis.) E. शूल colic, शतृ hostile.

शूलहस्त m. (-स्तः) One armed with a lance or pike. E. शूल, हस्त the hand.

शूलहृत् m. (-हृत्) Asafetida. E. शूल colic, and हृत् removing.

शूलाकृत mfn. (-तः-ता-त) Roasted on a spit, (meat.) E. शूल a spit, and कृत made, with डाच् augment; spitted.

शूलाग्र n. (-ग्र) The point of a pike, stake, &c. E. शूल, and अग्र end.

शूलक n. (-क) Roast meat. m. (-कः) A hare. E. शूल a spit, and उक् aff.

शूलिन् mfn. (-ली-लिनी-लि) 1. Suffering sharp pain, having the colic, &c. 2. Armed with a spear. m. (-ली) 1. MAHA'DÉVA. 2. A spearman. 3. A stake-bearer. 4. A hare. E. शूल a trident, and इनि aff.

शूलिन m. (-नः) The Indian-fig tree. E. शूल a stake, इन् aff. राज्या ।

शूलीत्खा f. (-त्खा) A medicinal plant, (Serratula anthelmintica.) “सीम-शूल्य mfn. (-ल्यः-ल्य-ल्य) 1. Roasted, (on a spit.) 2. Deserving impale-ment. n. (-ल्य) Roasted meat. E. शूल a spit, and यत् aff.

शूर् r. 1st cl. (शूर्ति) 1. To bring forth, to propagate. 2. To beget.

शूकाल m. (-लः) A jackal : see the next.

शूगाल m. (-लः) 1. A shakal or jackal. 2. A coward, a poltroon. 3. A rogue, a cheat. 4. An ill-natured or harsh-speaking man. 5. A demon so named. 6. KRISHN'A. f. (-ली) 1. Flight, retreat. 2. A fox. 3. A she-jackal. E. शूर्ज् to create or abandon, (deceit, &c.) कालन् aff.; or शूर्ज् a horn, अ negative prefix, ला to possess, aff. क्त, deriv. irr.; also शूगाल, &c.

शूगालकण्टक m. (-कः) A plant, commonly Séyála-kán'tá or jackal's thorn, (Zizyphus scandens.) E. शूगाल, कण्टक a thorn.

शूगालकीलि m. (-लिः) A sort of jujube. E. शूगाल a jackal, कीलि the jujube.

शूगालजम्बू f. (-म्बूः) 1. A kind of cucumber, (Cucumis madraspatanus.) 2. The fruit of the jujube. E. शूगाल a jackal, जम्बू rose-apple. “गीमुक् ।”

शूगालिका f. (-का) 1. The female jackal. 2. A fox. 3. Running away, flight, retreat. 4. A plant, (Convolvulus paniculatus.) E. शूगाली as above, and कन् added.
