

सत्युत्तम m. (-त्तः) 1. The father of a son. 2. A virtuous son. 3. A son who performs all the prescribed rites in honour of his ancestors.

E. सत् being or good, and पुत्र a son.

सत्यरूप m. (-रुः) A worthy or spirited man. E. सत् and पुरुष a male.

सत्यतिपक्ष m. (-क्षः) Contrariety of doctrine or argument, knowledge of the opposite arguments proving the existence or non-existence of a thing; viz.—sound is eternal because it is audible; on the other hand sound is non-eternal because it is a product, (in logic.) E. सत् being, प्रतिपक्ष opposition.

सत्यफल m. (-लः) The pomegranate. E. सत् good, and फल fruit.

सत्य mfn. (-त्यः-त्या-त्वे) 1. True. 2. Sincere, honest, speaking the truth. n. (-त्य) 1. Truth. 2. An oath. 3. The first Yuga or age, the golden age, comprising one million seven hundred and twenty-eight thousand years. 4. Demonstrated conclusion. m. (-त्यः) 1. RA'MA-CHANDRA. 2. The uppermost of the seven Lokas or worlds, the abode of BRAHMA', and heaven of truth. f. (-त्या) 1. SI'TA', the wife of RA'MA. 2. The mother of VYA'SA. 3. DRAUPADI'. 4. DURGA'. 5. SATYABHAMA'. 6. Speaking the truth, sincerity, veracity. Ind. (सत्यम्) Indeed, verily, a particle of interrogation and asseveration. E. सत् being, and यत् aff.

सत्यक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) True, veracious. n. (-कं) Ratification of a bargain. E. सत्य as above, कन् added.

सत्यङ्कार m. (-रः) Ratification of a bargain. E. सत्य truth, कार् making, confirming, सुम् augment.

सत्यङ्कारकृत mfn. (-तः-ता-कं) Given or deposited in order to bind or ratify a bargain. E. सत्यङ्कार as above, and कृत made.

सत्यता f. (-ता) Truth, trueness. E. तल् added to सत्य; also with त्व, सत्यत्व।

सत्यधन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Virtuous, sincere, upright. E. सत्य, धन wealth.

सत्यभामा f. (-मा) One of KRISHN'A's wives and daughter of SATRA'JIT. E. सत्य true, भाम beautiful, fem. form.

सत्यभारत m. (-तः) VYA'SA, the poet. E. सत्य true, भारत the Maha'bha'rata.

सत्ययुग n. (-ग) The first of the four Yugas or ages, the period of general virtue and purity, or golden age, comprising a term of 1,728,000 years. E. सत्य truth, युग age. [यौवन youth.]

सत्ययौवन m. (-नः) A Vidya'dhara or demi-god so named. E. सत्य truth, यौवन youth.

सत्यरत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Honest, sincere. m. (-तः) VYA'SA. E. सत्य the truth, and रत devoted to.

सत्यवक्तृ mfn. (-ता-त्री-तृ) A speaker of truth. E. सत्य, वक्तृ who speaks.

सत्यवचन n. (-नं) 1. Speaking truth. 2. Acknowledging or admitting truth. E. सत्य, and वचन speech.

सत्यवचस् mfn. (-चाः-चा-चः) Speaking truth, veracious. m. (-चाः) A Rishi, a saint, a seer. n. (-चः) Truth. E. सत्य truth, वचस् speech.

सत्यवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) True, possessing or practising truth. m. (-वान्) The name of a king. f. (-वती) 1. The mother of a VYA'SA, and wife of PARA'SARA. 2. The wife of NA'BADA. 3. The wife of RISHIKA, a saint. E. सत्य truth, सतुप् aff. [सुत son.]

सत्यवतीसुत m. (-तः) The poet VYA'SA. E. सत्यवती his mother's name, सुत son.

सत्यवद्य mfn. (-द्यः-द्या-द्यं) True-speaking, veracious. m. (-द्यः) Truth. E. सत्य, and वद् to speak, with क्यप् or यत् aff.

सत्यवाच् mfn. (-वाक्) Speaking truth, veracious, sincere. m. (-वाक्) 1. A crow. 2. A Rishi, a saint. E. सत्य true, वाच् speech.

सत्यवादिल n. (-ल) Speaking truth. E. सत्यवादिन्, ल aff. [speaks.]

सत्यवादिन् mfn. (-दी-दिनी-दि) Speaking truth. E. सत्य truth, वादिन् who speaks.

सत्यवृत्त mfn. (-त्तः-त्ता-त्तं) Practising or speaking the truth. E. सत्य truth, and वृत्त chosen.

सत्यव्रत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Practising or adhering to the truth, veracious, honest, sincere. m. (-तः) A king, the 25th of the solar dynasty in the second age. E. सत्य the truth, व्रत religious observance.

सत्यसङ्गाग्र mfn. (-ग्रः-शा-ग्रं) Likely, probable, possible, like the truth. E. सत्य truth, सङ्गाग्र like; also, similar compounds, as सत्यसन्निभ, &c.

सत्यसङ्कर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) True, veracious. m. (-रः) KUVU'RA, the god of wealth. E. सत्य the truth, सं with ग् to swallow, aff. ञप्।

सत्यसन्ध mfn. (-न्धः-न्धा-न्धं) Veracious, adhering to or observing the truth. m. (-न्धः) 1. RA'MA. 2. BHARATA, the younger brother of RA'MA. 3. The prince JANAME'JAYA. f. (-न्धा) DRAUPADI', the wife of PA'NDU princes. E. सत्य truth, सं before धा to have or hold, aff. क।

सत्यसाक्षिन् m. (-क्षी) An unexceptionable witness. E. सत्य, साक्षिन् a witness.

सत्याहति f. (-तिः) Ratification of a bargain. E. सत्य truth, आङ् before क् to make, to confirm, aff. क्तिन्. [अग्नि fire.]

सत्याग्नि m. (-ग्निः) A name of the saint AGASTYA. E. सत्य the truth, and सत्याग्नि mfn. (ज्ञा-त्या-त्तं) True. m. (-ज्ञा) A virtuous and upright man. E. सत्य, and आत्मन् Soul.

सत्यानुरक्त mfn. (-क्तः-क्ता-क्तं) Upright, true. E. सत्य, and अनुरक्त attached to.

सत्यावृत्त n. (-त्तं) Commerce, trade, traffic. E. सत्य truth, and अवृत्त falsehood, a mixed practice of truth and lies.

सत्यापन nf. (-नं-ना) Ratification of a bargain. E. सत्य nominal verb, to speak or observe the truth, causal form, सत्याप, and लुट् or युच् aff.

सत्योत्कर्ष m. (-र्षः) Eminence or excellence in truth. E. सत्य, and उत्कर्ष excellence. [said or uttered.]

सत्योद्य mfn. (-द्यः-द्या-द्यं) Speaking the truth. E. सत्य the truth, उद्य to be.

सत्त्व r. 10th cl. (सत्त्वते) 1. To act liberally. 2. To be connected. 3. To spread or extend.

सत्त्व n. (-त्वं) Sacrifice, &c.: see सत्त्वं।

सत्त्वप mfn. (-पः-पा-पं) Ashamed, modest. E. सत्त्वं with, पश्चात् shame.

सत्त्वजातक n. (-कं) Meat which has been once fried with spices, &c., then soaked and dried, and again dressed with Ghee and condiments.

E. सत्त्वं for सद् with, त्रि three, जातक species of production.

सत्त्व n. (-त्वं) The quality of excellence or goodness, &c.: see सत्त्वं।

सत्त्वर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Quick, expeditious. n. Adv. (-रं) Quickly, swiftly. E. सत्त्वं for सद् with, त्वरा dispatch.

सत्त्वरता f. (-ता) Quickness, speed. E. तल् added to the last; also with त्व, सत्त्वरत्वं। [connection]

सत्त्वसर्ग m. (-र्गः) Association with the good or respectable. E. सत्त्वं, संसर्ग

सत्त्वसङ्ग m. (-ङ्गः) Association with the good. E. सत्त्वं, and सङ्ग association.

सत्त्वनिधान n. (-नं) Association or intercourse with the wise and good. E. सत्त्वं, and सन्निधान propinquity.

सत्त्वमागम m. (-मः) Association with the good. E. सत्त्वं, समागम encounter.

सत्त्वसाय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) 1. Having a friend. 2. Having virtuous friends. E. सत्त्वं being, or good, &c. साहाय a friend.

सत्त्वसार m. (-रः) 1. A painter. 2. A poet. Adj. Having good essence. E. सत्त्वं excellence, सार essence.

सत्त्वस्फुर n. (-र) Sputtering in speech. E. सत्त्वं for सद् with, धृत् imitative sound, and कार् making.

सदंशक m. (-कः) A crab. E. सत्त्वं with, दंशक a tooth.

सदंशवदन m. (-नः) A heron. E. सत्त्वं with, दंश a tooth or beak, वदन face.

सद्द m. (-दः) The fruit of trees. E. पद् to go, अच् aff.

सदञ्जन n. (-नं) Calx of brass. E. सत्त्वं good, excellence, अञ्जन stibium.

सदन् n. (-नं) 1. A house. 2. Water. 3. Perishing, decaying. 4. Exhaustion. 5. A sacrificial hall. E. पद् to go or perish, aff. युच् or लुट्।

सदय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Benevolent, compassionate. E. सत्त्वं with, दय clemency.

सदर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Fearful, afraid. E. सत्त्वं with, दर fear.

सदस्य n. (-दाः-दः) 1. An assembly, a meeting. 2. Seat, residence. E. पद् to go, (to which,) Una'di aff. असुन्।

सदसत् mfn. (-सत्-सती-सत्) 1. Existent and non-existent. 2. True and false. 3. Perceptible and non-perceptible. 4. Real and unreal. 5. Good and bad. 6. Virtuous and wicked. n. Du. 1. Entity and non-entity. 2. Good and evil. E. सत्त्वं, असत्त्वं untrue, &c.

सदसदात्मक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Being both real and unreal, existent and
