

सर्वकृत् n. (-त्) A mushroom. E. सर्प, and कृत् an umbrella.
 सर्पक n. (-त्) 1. Going, gliding. 2. The slow flight of an arrow nearly parallel to the ground. E. सर्प to go, कृत् aff. [aff.]
 सर्पत् mfn. (-पत्-पत्ती-पत्) Going, gliding, creeping. E. सर्प to go, पत् सर्वकृत् m. (-त्) An ichneumon.
 सर्वदंष्ट्र m. (-दंष्ट्रः) 1. A snake's tooth. 2. A plant, commonly Danti, (Croton polyandrum.) f. (-दंष्ट्रा) A plant, (Tragia involucrata.) E. सर्प, दंष्ट्र a tooth.
 सर्पफण(विज) m. (-जः) The snake-stone, a gem or pearl said to resemble in form the berry of the Abrus precatorius, and to be found in the head of the snake. E. सर्प a snake, फण hood, ज born.
 सर्पमुज्ज m. (-मुज्ज) 1. A peacock. 2. A crane. 3. A large snake. E. सर्प a snake, मुज्ज who eats.
 सर्पसन्धि m. (-सन्धिः) The snake-stone or carbuncle, or a jewel said to be found in the head of a snake, possessing also alexipharmic properties. E. सर्प a snake, and सन्धि a gem.
 सर्पसन्धि f. (-सन्धिः) A plant, commonly SARPA-KANKA'LI.
 सर्पराज m. (-जः) VA'SUKI, sovereign of the serpent race, inhabiting Pa'tala or the regions under the earth. E. सर्प a snake, राज a sovereign.
 सर्पसन्धि m. (-सन्धिः) A name of the prince JANAME'JAYA, the son of PARIKSHIT. E. सर्प a snake, and सन्धि a sacrifice, इति aff.; having compelled by Mantras all the snakes to be present at a sacrifice performed for their destruction, in retaliation of the death of his father who was killed by the bite of a snake; all were destroyed on this occasion except a few of the chiefs.
 सर्पसहा f. (-हा) A plant: see सर्पकहाली। [kills].
 सर्पहन् m. (-हन्) An ichneumon, a mungoose. E. सर्प a snake, हन् who सर्पाच n. (-च) The seed of the Elaeocarpus. f. (-चौ) A plant, commonly Kanka'lika'. E. सर्प a snake, चिचि the eye. [appellation].
 सर्पाख्य m. (-ख्यः) A plant, (Mesua ferrea.) E. सर्प a snake, आख्य an सर्पाङ्गी f. (-ङ्गी) A plant, Sarpa-kanka'li or a variety of it.
 सर्पाराति m. (-तिः) 1. GARUD'A. 2. An ichneumon. 3. A peacock. E. सर्प a snake, आराति an enemy.
 सर्पारि m. (-रिः) An ichneumon. E. सर्प a snake, and आरि an enemy; equally applicable to the peacock, &c.; see the last.
 सर्पावास n. (-सं) The sandal tree.
 सर्पाशन m. (-नः) A peacock. E. सर्प a snake and आशन food: see the last.
 सर्पिन् mfn. (-पिन्-पिन्-पिन्) Going gently or tortuously, gliding, winding, creeping. f. (-पिन्) 1. A female serpent. 2. A small medicinal shrub. E. सर्प a snake, or going, &c., इति aff.
 सर्पिसत् Adj. Seasoned with clarified butter.
 सर्पिस n. (-पिन्) Ghee, clarified butter. E. सर्प to flow, इस् Una'di aff.
 सर्पिससुद्र m. (-सुद्रः) The sea of clarified butter, one of the seven seas, E. सर्पिस Ghee, सुसुद्र the ocean.
 सर्पेष्ट n. (-ष्ट) Sandal.
 सर्व r. 1st cl. (सर्वेति) To go, to move.
 सर्व mfn. (-सर्वः-सर्वः-सर्वः) All, whole, entire. E. सर्व to go, aff. चच्; as differently read, with a final som i vowel, सर्वे q. v.
 सर्वसह mfn. (-हः-हा-हः) 1. Patient, enduring. 2. All-sustaining. E. सर्व all, सह to bear, खच् aff.; see सर्वसह below.
 सर्व m. (-सर्व) 1. Sky, heaven. 2. Going, motion. E. सर्व to go, मन् Una'di aff.
 सर्व r. 1st cl. (सर्वेति) To hurt, to injure, to kill; more commonly सर्वे q. v.
 सर्व mfn. (-सर्वः-सर्वः-सर्वः) All, whole, complete, universal, entire. m. (-सर्वः) 1. S'IVA. 2. VISHN'U. E. सर्व to go, to pervade, (the world,) वन् Una'di aff.; also according to some authorities preferable, सर्वे as above.
 सर्वसह mfn. (-हः-हा-हः) 1. Patient, enduring. 2. All-sustaining. f. (-हा) The earth. E. सर्व all, (men,) सह to bear or suffer, aff. खच्।
 सर्विक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) All, every. E. कन् added to the last.
 सर्विकर्तृ m. (-र्तृ) BRAHMA'. E. सर्व all, (things,) कर्तृ maker. [कर्तृन्] det.
 सर्विकर्तृन् n. (-र्तृ) All or every act. m. (-र्तृ) A man of all work. E. सर्व,

सर्विकर्तृन् mfn. (-र्तृ-र्तृ-र्तृ) Performing or conversant with every business, pervading every action, &c. E. सर्व all, कर्तृ act, खच् aff. [makes].
 सर्विकारिन् mfn. (-रि-रि-रि) The maker of all things. E. सर्व, कारिन् who सर्वकाल n. (-काल) All seasons or times. E. सर्व, and काल time.
 सर्वकालीन mfn. (-नः-कालीन) Of all times or seasons. E. सर्वकाल, and खच् aff.
 सर्वेके Ind. Every where, universally. E. सर्व in all, and चकच् inserted before the final.
 सर्वकेशिन् m. (-शे) An actor, a dancer, a mime.
 सर्वचार m. (-रः) Any substance of an alkaline or soapy nature, as impure soda, pearl ash or potash, &c., which may be used in cleaning clothes. E. सर्व all चार impure alkali or alkaline salt or ashes.
 सर्वेग mfn. (-गः-गः-गः) Going every where, all-pervading. n. (-गः) Water. m. (-गः) 1. S'IVA. 2. BRAHMA'. 3. Soul, spirit. 4. Air, wind. f. (-गा) A plant, commonly Priyangu. E. सर्व all, ग what goes.
 सर्वगत mfn. (-तः-गत-तः) Omnipresent, universally diffused. E. सर्व, गत gone.
 सर्वगन्ध m. (-न्धः) 1. A class of four aromatics, or kakkol, cloves, agallochum, and gum benjamin. 2. A perfume in general. E. सर्व all, and गन्ध fragrance. [aff.]
 सर्वेयन्त्रिक n. (-न्त्रिक) The root of long-pepper. E. सर्व all, यन्त्रि a knot, कन् सर्वेयन्त्रिक mfn. (-न्त्रिक-वा-न्त्रिक) 1. All-pervading, diffused, extended. 2. All-destroying. m. (-न्त्रिक) A rogue, a wicked man. E. सर्व, and कच् to go, खच् aff.
 सर्वेचर्मीय mfn. (-चर्मीय-चर्मीय) Made of every kind of skin or leather. E. सर्व all, चर्मी skin, खच् aff.
 सर्वजगत् f. (-जगत्) The universe, the whole world. E. सर्व, and जगत् world.
 सर्वजनीन mfn. (-नीन-नीन) Belonging or relating to all men, fit for all, &c. E. सर्व all, जन mankind, खच् aff.
 सर्वजित् mfn. (-जित्) 1. All-subduing, irresistible. 2. All-surpassing, excellent, incomparable. m. (-जित्) The twenty-first year of the cycle. E. सर्व all, जित् who subdues or surpasses.
 सर्वज्ञ mfn. (-ज्ञः-ज्ञः-ज्ञः) Omniscient, all-wise. m. (-ज्ञः) 1. S'IVA. 2. A Jina or Budd'ha, or deified sage peculiar to those sects. E. सर्व all, and ज्ञ who knows. [सर्वज्ञता।
 सर्वज्ञान n. (-ज्ञान) Omniscience. E. ज्ञ added to the last; also with तल्.
 सर्वज्ञःयुभा f. (-भा) A plant, (Priyangu.) E. सर्वज्ञत् wholly, युभ auspicious.
 सर्वज्ञान m. (-ज्ञान) A man who has studied the Tantra-Sha'stras. E. सर्वज्ञ all, तन्त्र a Tantra, properly with an affix of derivation, &c., as उक्, and that again rejected.
 सर्वज्ञत् Ind. 1. Every way, all-round. 2. Wholly, entirely. 3. From every body. E. सर्व all, ज्ञिच् aff.
 सर्वज्ञापन m. (-नः) Love or the deity KA'MA. E. सर्व all, तापन inflamer.
