(-व) 1. A plant, a sort of Sida. 2. A twining shrub, (Echites frutescens.) 3. Another plant, also Dan'do'tpala. f. (-वै) 1. A sort of Sida. 2. A shrub, bearing a fragrant seed, Priyangu.
