खादन n. (-नं) Tasting, either as food or drink, eating, drinking. E. खाद् to taste, aff. लुट् । [aff. क्त ।]

खादित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Tasted, touched with the lips. E. खाद् to taste, खादिमन् m. (-मा) Savouriness, sweetness.

खादिष्ठ f. (-ष्ठा) Adj. Very sweet. E. Superlative of खाद् ।

खादीयस् f. (-सौ) Adj. More sweet. E. Comparative of खाद् ।

खादु mfn. (-दुः-दुः or -दुः-दुः) 1. Sweet. 2. Agreeable, desired. 3. Handsome. 4. Grateful to the palate, dainty, delicate. m. (-दुः) 1. The sweet taste or flavour, sweetness. 2. Treacle, molasses. 3. A medicinal root and perfume commonly Jivaka. f. (-दुः or -दुः) A grape. E. खद् to taste or to be pleasing, उण् Una'di aff.

खादुकण्टक m. (-कः) 1. A plant, (Flacourtia sapida.) 2. A sort of creeper, (Tribulus lanuginosus.) E. खाद् sweet, and कण्टक a thorn.

खादुकार mfn. (-रः-रौ-रं) Delicate in taste, dainty. E. खाद्, कार who acts.

खादुखण्ड m. (-खः) 1. Molasses, raw sugar. 2. A piece of any sweet substance. E. खाद् sweet, खण्ड a fragment.

खादुगन्ध f. (-न्धा) A creeper, (Convolvulus paniculatus,) the dark sort. E. खाद् sweet, गन्ध smell.

खादुधन्वन् m. (-न्वा) KA'MA. E. खाद् sweet, (flowers,) धन्वन् a bowyer.

खादुफल n. (-लं) The fruit of the jujube. f. (-ला) The jujube tree. E. खाद् sweet, फल fruit. [sweet, मञ्जन् sap.]

खादुमञ्जन् m. (-ञ्जा) A sort of tree, a Pilu growing in the hills. E. खाद्

खादुमूल n. (-लं) A carrot. "गाजर" इति भाषा. E. खाद् sweet, मूल a root.

खादुरसा f. (-सा) 1. A medicinal root, commonly, Ka'koli. 2. The fruit of the hog-plum. 3. Vinous liquor. 4. A grape. 5. The S'ata'vari plant. E. खाद् sweet, &c., and रस juice.

खादुशीत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Sweet and cool. E. खाद्, and शीत cold.

खादुशुद्ध n. (-द्धं) Rock or river salt. E. खाद् sweet, and शुद्ध pure.

खादन्न n. (-न्नं) Dainties, delicacies, choice food. E. खाद्, and अन्न food.

खादन्न m. (-न्नः) The pomegranate tree. E. खाद् sweet, and अन्न sour.

खाधिकार m. (-रः) Own or peculiar office or station. E. स्व, अधिकार duty.

खाधिपत्य n. (-त्यं) Supreme sway, royalty, sovereignty. E. स्व, and आधिपत्य supremacy. [body.]

खाधिष्ठान n. (-नं) One of the six CHAKRAS or mystical circles of the

खाधीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) 1. Independent, uncontrolled. 2. One's own dependent. E. स्व self, अधीन dependent.

खाधीनकुशल Adj. Having prosperity in one's own power.

खाधीनता f. (-ता) Independence. E. तल् added to the last ; also with त्, खाधीनत् ।

खाधीनपतिका f. (-का) A woman independent of her husband or lover. E. खाधीन independent, पति husband, कन् fem. form added.

खाधीनभर्तृका f. (-का) A woman who is independent of her lover or husband. E. स्व self, अधीन subservient, and भर्तृ a husband, कन् added ; keeping her husband in subjection or dependence.

खाध्याय m. (-यः) 1. Inaudible reading or muttering of prayers. 2. The Ve'das or scripture. 3. Perusal or study of the Ve'das. E. स्व one's self, अध्याय reading. [Ve'das, मनुप् aff.]

खाध्यायवन् m. (-वान्) A student of the Ve'das. E. खाध्याय perusing the

खाध्यायिन् m. (-यी) 1. A tradesman, a citizen and dealer. 2. A student of the Ve'das. E. खाध्याय muttering, &c., इति aff.

खान m. (-नः) Sound, noise. E. खन् to sound, aff. चञ् ।

खानुभूति f. (-तिः) One's own experience, self-enjoyment.

खानुरूप mfn. (-पः-पौ-वं) Natural, inherent, innate. E. स्व, अनु रूप conformity.

खान् mfn. (-न्तः-न्ता-न्तं) Sounded, making a noise. n. (-न्) 1. The mind, the faculty of thought and feeling. 2. A cave, a cavern. E. खन् to sound, क्त aff., deriv. irr.

खाप m. (-पः) 1. Sleep, sleeping. 2. Sleepiness, sloth. 3. Paralysis, palsy, loss of sensation. 4. Ignorance. 5. Dreaming, a dream. 6. Temporary and partial palsy from pressure on a nerve, numbness, the sleep of a limb, &c. E. खप् to sleep, aff. चञ् ।

खापतेव n. (-यं) Wealth, property. E. स्व own, पति master, उण् aff.

खापद m. (-दः) A wild beast. E. स substituted for श् ; see चापद ।

खाभाविक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Natural, peculiar, inherent. m. Plu. (-काः) A sect of Bud'dhists who accounted for all things by the law of nature. E. स्वभाव natural property or nature, उक् aff. [affair.]

स्वामिकार्य n. (-र्यं) The business of a prince or master. E. स्वामिन्, कार्य

स्वामिजडिन् m. (-द्वी) PARAS'URA'MA.

स्वामिता f. (-ता) 1. Ownership. 2. Sovereignty. E. स्वामिन्, तल् aff. ; also with त्, स्वामित् ।

स्वामित्व n. (-त्वं) 1. Ownership, mastership. 2. Sovereignty, &c. E. त् added to स्वामिन् ; also with तल्, स्वामिता ।

स्वामिन् mfn. (-नी-मिनी-नि) Owner, proprietor, master or mistress, &c. m. (-नी) 1. A master, a lord. 2. A sovereign, a prince, a monarch. 3. A husband, a lover. 4. A spiritual preceptor. 5. A learned Bra'hman or Pan'dit'. 6. An ascetic or religious man of the highest order, (in this sense generally an addition to proper names.) 7. KA'RTIKEYA. 8. VISHN'U. 9. S'IVA. 10. The Muni VA'TSYA'YANA. 11. A name of GARUD'A. E. स्व own, चामिन्च् aff.

स्वामिपाल m. DU. (-लौ) The owner and the tender, (of cattle.)

स्वामिमूल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Depending upon, or originating from the master, husband, or lord. E. स्वामिन्, and मूल root.

स्वामिसद्भाव m. (-वः) 1. Existence of a master or owner. 2. Amiability of a master or lord. E. स्वामि, and सत् being, or good, भाव existence or property. [सिवा service.]

स्वामिसिवा f. (-वा) Attention to a master, husband, &c. E. स्वामिन्, and स्वास्य n. (-स्यं) 1. Mastership, ownership. 2. Right or title to property. 3. Rule, supremacy. E. स्वामिन्, यत् aff. [कन् added.]

स्वाम्युपकारक m. (-कः) A horse. E. स्वामिन् a master, उपकार assistance, स्वाम्यस् Adj. Depending upon oneself.

स्वाम्यव mfn. (-वः-वौ-वं) 1. Relating to SWAYAMBHU'. 2. Derived from the self-born. m. (-वः) An epithet of the first MANU, the son of SWAYAMBHU'. E. स्वाम्य, and अण् aff. ; also स्वाम्यम् । [poem.]

स्वाम्यस्विक f. (-का) Possessing inherent flavour or sweetness, (said of a स्वाम्यस्व n. (-स्यं) 1. The possessing natural savouriness or excellence. 2. Propriety, (of a word.)

स्वाम्यस्व m. (-राट्) INDRA. E. स्वर् heaven, राज ruler ; the first र rejected, and the vowel made long.

स्वाम्यस्व n. (-न्यं) 1. Final felicity, union with BRAHMA'. 2. INDRA'S heaven. E. स्वाम्य, and अण् aff. ; or स्वाम्यस्व and यत् aff.

स्वाम्यस्विक m. (-वः) The second MANU. स्वाम्यस्विक, and अण् affix of descent.

स्वाम्यस्विक mfn. (-यं-यौ-यं) 1. Pleonastic. 2. Having a plain or literal meaning, or similar force or sense. 3. Having one's own object. n. (-यं) 1. Property, substance. 2. Same effect or meaning, a pleonasm. 3. Own object or desire. m. (-यं) 1. Self-interest. 2. Own meaning. E. स्व own, and अर्थ wealth or sense.

स्वाम्यस्विक mfn. (-वः-वा-वं) Selfish. E. स्वाम्य, and परायण diligent.

स्वाम्यस्विक mfn. (-सुः-सुः-सुः) Desirous of having one's own way, self-seeking. E. स्वाम्य, and लिच्च् desirous of getting.

स्वाम्यस्विक m. (-नः) The frustration of one's own object.

स्वाम्यस्विकि f. (-दिः) Accomplishment of one's object, attainment of the thing desired. E. स्वाम्य, and सिच्च् completion.

स्वाम्यस्विकान n. (-नं) (In logic,) A particular process of induction, (as opposed to पराम्यस्विकान.)

स्वाम्यस्विक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) 1. Expressing its own or literal meaning. 2. Having one's own object. 3. Done with one's own wealth, &c. E. स्वाम्य, and उण् aff.
