(-य) The Hima'la or Hima'laya range of mountains, which bounds India on the north, and separates it from Tartary ; the Imaus and Emodus of the ancients, giving rise to the Ganges, and Indus, and many other considerable rivers, and containing the highest elevations in the world : in mythology, the mountain is personified as the husband of MENAKA', and the father of GANGA' or the Ganges, and DURGA' or UMA' in her descent as PARVATI', the mountain nymph, to captivate S'IVA, and withdraw him from a course of ascetic austerity practised in those regions.
