

पैत्तिक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Bilious.

पैत्र (चः-वा-चं) *a.* Paternal. *n.* The part of the hand between the thumb and fore-finger; a year, month or day of the *Pitrīs*.

पैत्राह्नि.रात्र (चः) 1. *m.* A day and night of the *Pitrīs* or progenitors, equal to a month of mortals.

पैत्रिक (कः-की-कं) *a.* Paternal.

पैल (लः) 1. *m.* A sage, teacher and promulgator of the *Rig Vēda*.

पैशाच (चः) 1. *m.* A mode of marriage, ravishment. *f.* (चो) A present to a friend on a holiday. *a.* Infernal, belonging to imps.

पैशुन (नं) 1. *n.* Information; espionage; slander; villany.

पैशुन्य (न्यं) 1. *n.* *Idem.*

पैष (एः-द्वा-एं) *p.* Ground. *f.* Spirits.

पैषिक (कं) 1. *n.* Quantity of cakes; spirits distilled from meal.

पैगङ्ग (ङः-ङ्गा-ङः) *a.* Deformed. *m.* A boy from 5 to 16.

पौट (उः) 1. *m.* The foundation of a house; mixing. *f.* (उ) Woman with a beard; a slave. (ई) *f.* A large alligator or crocodile.

पौट.गच (लः) 1. *m.* A reed (*Arundo tibialis*); sort of grass (*Sacharum spontaneum*); a fish.

पौटजिका (का) 1. *f.* A packet.

पौटिक (कः) 1. *m.* A boil.

पौड़ली (ल्ली) 3. *f.* A bundle, parcel. पौड़ु (डुः) 2. *m.* Lower part or surface of the skull, or parietal bone.

पौत (तः-ती) 1. *m.* 3. *f.* The young of any animal. *m.* A boat; a young elephant; site of a house; cloth.

पौतकी (की) 3. *f.* A potherb.

पौत.ज (जः) 1. *m.* An animal that produces without the intervention of a medium or uterus.

पौत.बणिज् (क) 5. *m.* A voyaging, or seafaring merchant. [boat.]

पौत.रक्त (चः) 1. *m.* The rudder of a boat.

पौतज्ञक.प्रिय (यः) 1. *m.* One of the *Jaina* teachers. [man.]

पौत.वाह (हः) 1. *m.* A rower, a boatman.

पौताच्छादन (नं) 1. *n.* A tent.

पौताधान (नं) 1. *n.* Small fry.

पौतिका (का) 1. *f.* A potherb.

पौद्व (वा) 1. *m.* An officiating priest at a sacrifice; *Vishnu*.

पौत्र (त्रं) 1. *m.* The snout of a hog; ploughshare; thunderbolt.

पौत्रायुध (धः) 1. *m.* A hog.

पौत्र.दंड्रा.ज (जः) 1. *m.* A gem supposed to be in the hog's tooth.

पौत्रिन् (त्री) 5. *m.* A hog.

पौत्र.रथा (था) 1. *f.* A goddess of the *Jainas*. [eyelid.]

पौथकी (की) 3. *f.* Pimples on the

पौल (लः) 1. *m.* Bulk; a heap.

पौलिका (का) 1. *f.* Flat cakes.

पौलिन्द (न्दः) 1. *m.* A part of a boat supporting the deck.
